## Case Management of Sexual and Gender Based Violence

### Patient entry into a health facility / Triage

- Ensure patient has face mask at Entrance
- Observe IPC and use appropriate PPE, Emphasize Hand and Respiratory Hygiene, Observe Social Distance
- Screen at main entrance to facility as per National COVID19 screening guidelines and provided tools

**Screened positive for violence and positive for COVID-19**

**Screened negative for violence but positive for COVID-19**

**Screened positive for violence but negative for COVID-19**

**Screened negative for violence and negative for COVID-19**

**Isolate & Notify IPC and GBV service Teams**

- Offer post GBV care Package
- Test for COVID 19 if meets criteria
- Share national and local hotlines for GBV & COVID 19

- Assess for GBV related risks at home and community
- Share national and local hotlines for GBV & COVID 19
- Consider testing for COVID 19 if meets criteria

- Offer post GBV care package
- Assess for GBV risks at home & community
- Design a feasible follow up plan for GBV related services

- Advice on social distancing mask and hand hygiene while in the community
- Assess for GBV risks at home & community
- Share national & local hotlines for GBV & COVID 19

### COVID 19 test results

#### Negative:

- Continue with GBV as per needed
- Give client national and local helplines for GBV & COVID 19

#### Positive

1. Isolate and manage as per positive COVID -19 guidelines
2. Integrate GBV health services in care plan
3. Refer and link to services as needed (psychosocial, legal etc.)
4. Design a feasible follow up plan for GBV at discharge from COVID 19 follow-up

#### Minimum Package for Post GBV Services

- Ensure survivor centered approach and prioritize the rights needs and wishes of the survivor
- Offer First line support and treat any injuries
- Undertake physical, and forensic examination (ensure chain of custody of evidence collected). Where applicable, Test for HIV initiate PEP as appropriate (full month dose), Commence Emergency contraception, treat for STI drugs
